INFORMATION SYSTEMS SECURITY UPDATE

Mr. Jefferey Saiger provided the board with the quarterly update on the progress made with the SURS Information Security program. Over the last quarter, staff has been focusing on governance and analytic capabilities. Recently, SURS has partnered with an IT advisory firm to evaluate the current set of security-related policies as well as to identify additional security measures that are being drafted into the SURS IT policies.
