

CLOSED SESSION MINUTES

Meeting of the Board of Trustees of the State Universities Retirement System Thursday, February 2, 2023, 4:00 p.m. Via remote access due to ongoing COVID-19 concerns

Upon motion by Trustee Van Meter, seconded by Trustee Hendrie, and following a roll call vote, the SURS Board of Trustees went into closed session pursuant to §2(c)(1) of the Open Meetings Act.
