GENERAL COUNSEL'S LITIGATION REPORT PENDING AND POTENTIAL LITIGATION MATTERS

Mr. Pontrelli of Foley & Lardner provided updated information regarding the pending claim and potential litigation matter involving Northern Trust. Trustees discussed the details and options pertaining to the situation.

Ms. Green provided the board with an update regarding recent pending litigation issues and highlighted a few developments that occurred since the last meeting. Based on information regarding the proposed new foreign action, the board directed Ms. Green to request approval from the Attorney's General office to join that opt-in foreign litigation matter and then proceed accordingly.

FRAUD REPORT

Ms. Green shared the Executive Director's Fraud Report and informed the board that she believes there is a "reasonable suspicion" that an outside party is attempting to defraud a SURS member by redirecting funds into a different bank account. She recommended that the matter be referred to the appropriate state's attorney for possible further action, pursuant to 40 ILCS 5/1-135.
