Meeting of the Investment Committee of the Board of Trustees of the State Universities Retirement System Thursday, March 9, 2023, 9:00 a.m. Via remote access due to ongoing COVID-19 concerns

UPDATE ON REAL ASSETS FUND CONTINUATION

Mr. Shane Willoughby stated that the documents regarding the proposed changes to a current real estate investment in Dune Real Estate Fund III were just received by SURS staff on March 8, 2023. At this time, there are still questions that Dune needs to address before staff can bring a recommendation to the board and executive committee for consideration on any proposed action. An executive committee meeting will be scheduled for early April 2023 to discuss this matter.

TAIL RISK REPORT

Mr. Bebee provided an update to the Tail Risk Hedging Program which covered the implementation and performance of the program, the costs, and the current portfolio positioning.
